## About Our Day Morning

Your child comes in and unpacks their backpacks. They take out their binder, water bottle, lunch box, snack, etc.

Once they have finished unpacking, they look to the Morning Task List. This might include morning work that includes a spiral review of previously learned skills or soft starts.

## Family Time

During family time, students are getting to know each other on a more meaningful level. Teachers might post a daily message and discuss what it means. Topics covered include ways to show leadership and character counts skills. The goal of family time is to build a classroom family and make connections.

## Related Arts

Your child is on a 10-day rotation for Related Arts. This year, we have PE (4 times), Music, Media, STEM, Art, Character Education and Computer Literacy.. We suggest wearing tennis shoes daily to be prepared.

## Lunch/Recess

We have lunch in the cafeteria and recess daily. Lunch is 30 minutes and recess is 20 minutes. The students make sure to bring their water bottles with them to stay hydrated.

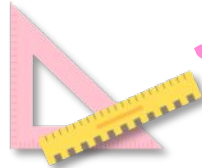
# Math Block
