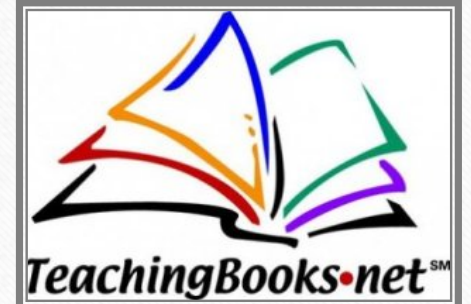
Florida Electronic Library

- No Username or Password is required.
- Allow the site to “Use my location” at this point you should see “St Johns Public Library” as your library but it also allows you to change libraries.
- This will give you thousands of resources based on your topic. You can choose magazines, academic journals, books, newspapers, videos, images, videos, and audio.
- Some articles will allow you to listen to the audio.

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For Educators:

- Click on “Sign In” then “Educator”
- Leave the username blank and the password is “stjohns.”.

*You can access online books by going to Browse, then Collections, and under Book Readings it will say “Complete Book and Poem Readings”

*Reviews, articles, information about the author for over 172,000 books

For Students:

- Click on “Sign In” and then “Student”
- Username is “stjohns” and the password is “stjohns”.

Top Places to find Ebooks

1. [St. Johns County Public Library](#) (you must have a library card). Go to “elibrary” and use Hoopla, Overdrive, or Rbdigital. They also come in apps available on mobile devices.
2. [The Gutenberg Project](#) 45,000 ebooks and access to 100,000 of their partners.
3. [Free-ebooks.net](#) Create a free account to access 5 free books a month. Paid accounts can access more.
4. Google Play’s ebookstore and Amazon Kindle have options for free ebooks.

Top Places to find Ebooks

5. [Feedbooks](#) is a platform for books that are public domain (i.e. classics) no account is necessary.
6. [Openlibrary.org](#) is like the Wikipedia of books. It is an editable library catalog. To borrow a book, you will need to create an account.
7. [Lit2go](#) is a collection of stories and poems with text and Mp3 formatted audio. Text and audio can be downloaded.
8. [MackinVia](#) ebooks from the Wards Creek collection. From the first page asking for your school/library, type in Wards Creek Elementary School, it will ask for your login which is your E# and computer password, for students it would be their S# and password. There aren't many titles, but some may help you.
