SAC is a diverse group of stakeholders of a school, established through Florida law, with the shared goal of increasing student achievement in a safe learning environment. SAC consists of the principal and an appropriately balanced number of teachers, staff, parents, and community members. Spotlight on Fifth Grade:

Over the past couple of weeks, fifth grade students at Wards Creek have begun two intervention/enrichment blocks in the morning to assist students in reading and math instruction. These instructional groupings are designed to give students specialized instruction in the aforementioned content areas. The math sessions include math multiplication games like "Blockout" and multiplication bingo, multiplying 3 digit by 3 digit numbers using the multiplication algorithm, and advanced math projects based on multiplication and division. Students in the reading sessions are working on various skills. Some are learning how to be active readers while using reading strategies effectively by identifying key ideas and details. Other students are meeting in daily "Literature Circles" where they read novels and collaborate with each other during discussion times while another group may spend more time focusing on vocabulary and multiple meaning words. Be sure to ask your fifth grader what he/she is learning during their reading and math intervention blocks!
