The Governor has issued a proclamation calling upon public officials, schools, private organizations and all residents of the state to commemorate Medal of Honor Day and honor recipients of the Congressional Medal of Honor who distinguished themselves through their conspicuous bravery and gallantry during wartime and at considerable risk to their own lives, while serving as members of the United States Armed Forces. Monday, March 25th is Florida's observance of Medal of Honor Day 2019. Section 683.147, Florida Statute 1003.42. 2019-2020 Registration Information: Registration for the 2019-2020 school year is now open. SJCSD has developed a new online application. Therefore, all new registrations will be done via the online form. Wildly Important Goals:

Wards Creek Elementary believes that community service is a vital part of its role in shaping tomorrow's leaders and seeks to find ways to instill this belief in students. The goal of service projects is to develop purposeful and contributing citizens who are aware of their responsibilities – to themselves, their school, and society. Learning how to care lies at the heart of our leaders and the value of responsible citizenship, caring for a cause beyond oneself. Our goal is that 100% of our students participate in at least one community service project by the end of the school year.

Attached is a letter from Mrs. Mitidieri regarding a school-wide community service project. Crayola and schools across North America are banding together to help kids understand the importance of their role in protecting the environment. The Crayola ColorCycle initiative encourages students to collect and repurpose used Crayola markers. Highlighters and dry erase markers can also be included. The ColorCycle program has repurposed more than 70 tons of expended markers in the United States and Canada since 2013, and uses the most advanced plastic conversion technologies available today to make wax compounds for asphalt and roofing shingles as well as to generate electricity that can be used to heat homes, cook food, and power vehicles. Drop-off boxes will be located inside the yellow house.

Spotlight on 2nd Grade:

2nd grade recently visited GTM where the students had a chance to learn about all the plants and animals that live in an estuary. They were very excited to use binoculars and find an eagle's nest. The children continue to write letters to veterans as our community service project. As the 4th quarter approaches, the students are working very hard to reach one year's growth on i-Ready for reading and math.
