Spotlight on ESE:

All 2-5 ESE Reading students have been provided access to a new online reading program, Reading Rangers. By using Reading Rangers, your child will strengthen phonics and vocabulary, reinforce comprehension, and build fluency. Your child will earn tokens and game credits while completing activities in the program. Encourage your child to use Reading Rangers two to three times a week for 15– 20 minutes per session.
