Meet and Greet

This is the time for you to meet your child's teacher and bring in school supplies. We are asking families to try to not stay in the classroom for more than 10 minutes. This time is really meant to introduce your child to his/her new teacher and drop off supplies. Our teachers communicate effectively throughout the year. So, they will keep you informed about the growth of your child.

3rd, 4th, and 5th Grade 10:00-12:00 a.m.

Kindergarten Staggered Start

All kindergarten students in St. Johns County, participate in a staggered start. ***This means that students sign up for one day during the first three days of school where they will attend in a small group. This allows the teachers to provide students with individualized attention and teach daily routines and procedures.*** Staggered start will be Wednesday, August 10th through Friday, August 12th. Your child's teacher will send a welcome letter with a Signup Genius for the day that works best for you. **ALL KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS WILL COME TO SCHOOL ON MONDAY, AUGUST 15th.**

First Week of School Arrival

Parents are welcome to walk their child to class the first week of school. All students enter through the bus loop and parent pickup loop doors. **You must go to the front office to sign in prior to escorting your child to class. Remember to bring your ID! If you have not completed a School Access Form visit <https://www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/volunteer/>. This form is required in order to enter the building and is good for three years.**

Instructional Day

It is critically important that all children arrive on time to school each day. This is a key part of how you can support our success. The instructional day for students is from 8:25-2:45 with early release on Wednesdays at 1:45.

Extended Day

Wards Creek is pleased to provide extended day services to our families. We offer both before care beginning at 6:30 a.m. and after care until 6 p.m. ***If you wish to enroll your child and have not done so already, you will need to complete an Extended Day Registration Form and pay the registration fee.
