### 7 FACTS MOST PEOPLE DON'T KNOW ABOUT TYPE 1 DIABETES

#### 1. TYPE 1 DIABETES IS AN AUTOIMMUNE DISEASE

The body's immune system attacks and destroys the insulin-producing cells in the pancreas, the beta cells. The person's pancreas stops producing insulin.

#### 2. INSULIN IS A HORMONE... NOT A DRUG

Insulin is the hormone that allows energy to enter our cells. Everyone needs insulin to live. People with type 1 diabetes have to take insulin multiple times a day either with an insulin pump or injections.

#### 3. TID IS NOT PREVENTABLE OR REVERSIBLE

The cause of T1D is still unknown. It is NOT caused by diet and lifestyle choices as many people believe. Type 1 diabetes is not anyone's fault.

#### 4. TYPE 1 DIABETES IS NOT CONTAGIOUS

It's impossible to "catch" any type of diabetes.

#### 5. PEOPLE WITH TYPE 1 DIABETES CAN EAT SUGAR

People with type 1 diabetes can eat anything everyone else eats. The difference is that they need to give themselves insulin for the carbohydrates they eat. People with type 1 diabetes sometimes NEED sugar to combat low blood glucose levels.

### 6. HIGH AND LOW BLOOD SUGARS HAVE A BIG IMPACT

A person's glucose level changes throughout the day based on food intake, activity, and many other factors. Blood sugar fluctuations affect the person's body, emotions, and thinking.


#### 7. INSULIN IS NOT A CURE

Insulin is a treatment. There is no cure for T1D. It doesn't go away and no one grows out of it.

For a person with T1D, insulin is required 24/7 for the rest of their life.

### November Diabetes Awareness Month

Type one diabetes means your pancreas does not produce insulin, these warriors must monitor their blood glucose levels continuously throughout the day and get insulin injections with a pump or pen. Currently there is no cure for Type 1 diabetes.
