 - When I visit classrooms, I will ask students: What are your learning? Why are you learning it? How does this help you?
- Support the school's rules and expectations for students (PBIS Handbook, Social Contract).
 - Treat all citizens of Wards Creek Elementary School with respect and civility (faculty, staff, students, parents).
